Half of the proceeds went to The Rotary Foundation's PolioPlus Fund, which pays for our polio eradication efforts. The envelope was also used as part of a social media campaign to raise awareness of polio, a paralyzing disease. - The Food Plant Solutions Rotary Action Group is combating hunger through a gardening guide that teaches communities about planting native crops and how to be self-sufficient. - Rotarians from the International Fellowship of Rotarian Musicians have been making music for years. They moved their meetings online when the pandemic started.
